- Did what seemed right in his eyes
- Lost his spiritual authority/anointing
- Eventually lost influence in the kingdom

DAVID

- Started out humble
- Obeyed the voice of the Lord
- Submitted to spiritual authority
- Sought to please the Lord
- Was not afraid to repent for sins/mistakes made (Psalm 51)
- Although far from perfect, kept his spiritual authority/anointing
- Maintained influence in the kingdom
